

In Dialogue CAT Practitioner Training Year 1 (2025) _Online.

- Structure: Blended format with 16 hours of pre-recorded modules and 32 hours of live seminars and mapping workshops.
- Content: Explores CAT principles, relational mapping, reformulation techniques, and practical therapeutic applications.
- Requirements: Open to qualified professionals with prior experience in psychology, social work, occupational therapy, psychiatric nursing or related fields.
- Supervision: Requires 40 sessions of group CAT supervision each year (not included in course fees), and trainees must complete supervised CAT therapies to be accredited.
- Assessments: Includes quizzes, a mid-year oral presentation, and a year-end written case study.
